## UPDATE ON REOPENING

On the 28th of May The Chief Dental Officer announced that all dental and orthodontic practices across England will be allowed to begin the process of reopening from Monday 8th of June. We would like to thank you all for your patience and understanding over the last 10 weeks.

Since our closure on the 24th March we have been working extremely hard to ensure we are doing everything we can to meet the governments new guidelines by introducing additional safety measures to make sure we can return to providing care to our patient's as safely as possible.

As of today 2nd June we are still waiting for updated guidelines from governing bodies. Once we have received these then we can start to determine which procedures can be carried out , we only then can start to ask patients to attend the practice.

As we begin to open we will be aiming to contact those patients firstly who are in pain and require urgent care, followed by patient's who had appointments cancelled during lockdown, we appreciate your patience with this.

We are currently awaiting stock of PPE which as i am sure you have heard in the news is proving difficult to get hold of but as this is a priority in ensuring we obtain the correct amount of PPE to ensure we can protect both our staff and patient's. We are also working very hard implementing into our practice lots of new safety measures to protect yourselves and our staff.

We will begin the process of re-opening from the 8th of June. Due to COVID-19 we are having to make some changes to how the practice runs day to day. These changes include a strict policy of no entry into the practice, the doors will be locked and only patient's will be asked to come in at there allotted appointment time. We cannot allow patient's to wait inside so you will be met at the door by a member of the team to attend your appointment. So we kindly ask that you do not attend ahead of the time given for your appointment. Please also understand this is a slow process and we ask that you do not attend the practice unless you have an appointment. This means we will be contacting patients and only offering appointments to patients in pain, followed by patients who have been cancelled during lockdown.
